Greek Dinner Chef Bobbie

Besides gifting our club with her cooking expertise along with **Peter the Greek, Rita "Bobbie" Habermann** is a well known sculptor. She was born in Winterbach, Southern Germany. Her passion of working with clay started as a teenager in her home town. Initially she followed pottery courses there. She now lives in Luxembourg. She loves traveling, especially to Kaua'i, Hawai'i, Greece, and Namibia.

After having moved around Europe, her creativity redirected her to the field of sculpture. For several years she studied with the Belgian sculptor **Jean-Luc Coyette**. At the same time she followed sculpture workshops with the French artist **Xavier Duver** in St. Victor/Ardèche/France, the Italo-American Artist **Paul Lucchesi** in Fabbiano/Tuscany/Italy, with **Prof. Gassmann** at the "Europäische Akademie für Bildende Künste" in Trier/Germany, and with sculptor **Martine Vaugel** in the Loire Valley in France.

The main objective of her classical as well as her abstract work is to give delight to people,

to touch and move them by sculptures created from a humble block of clay.



Bobbie says: I love working with my hands creating all sorts of objects and have been a disciple of famous sculptor **Paul Lucchesi**. Over the years I have experimented with various aspects of sculpture from Patina oriented items to fully-blown bronze masterpieces. My favorite items are the sculptures of the Himba people of Namibia, which are not for sale.
