RULES: This series of races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). U.S. Sailing and HYRA prescriptions with NYC modifications will apply. The number of races in this series will be indicated in the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY: The races are open to the following classes: Monohull & Multihull with LOA over 21' (3 boats are required to make a class) & Open (Monohull & Multihull) combined if individual classes are not established in both. There is no entry fee and NYC membership not required.

SKIPPER'S MEETING: There will be a skipper's meeting at 0900 hours at the picnic tables at the NYC Clubhouse.

SCHEDULE: The scheduled time of the warning signal for the race start is 1000 hours. Subsequent classes will start at 10-minute intervals.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the 0900 skipper's meeting.

SCORING: Scoring will be Low Point using HYRA modifications and NYC 'Club Adjustment' scoring system. There are no throw outs in this race.

PRIZES: Trophies will be awarded at the Annual Awards Ceremony. The number of trophies awarded will depend on the number of boats participating. First place winners of each class will be named on the Opening Day Perpetual Trophy.
