Commodore's Corner

We are entering what is commonly referred to elsewhere as the Dog Days of Summer, a period of sultry weather from about July 3rd to August 11th. Named in early times by observers in the counties bordering the Mediterranean, the period was reckoned as extending from 20 days before to 20 days after the conjunction of Sirius (the Dog Star) and the Sun. Sirius is the brightest star in the Hawaiian night sky and is commonly called A'a. It passes directly over Tahiti and Polynesian navigators used it to find their way back from Hawai'i. Perhaps we at NYC can call this period the Horse and Pony Days of Summer as **THE HORSE AND PONY SERIES** started on June 25th and will continue through July 23rd.

NYC Notice of Race

WAHINE SERIES

Thursdays

July 30, August 13, August 20, August 27

RULES: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and by the prescriptions of HYRA with NYC modifications.

ELIGIBILITY: The race is open to the following classes: Monohull & Multihull with LOA over 21' (3 boats are required to make a class) & Open (Monohull & Multihull) combined if individual classes are not established in both); **This four-race series will have the requirement that each boat have a Wahine (female) at the helm while racing for your score to count normally.** If you compete in a race without a female helmsman, you will be scored the number of starters in that race plus 2 points. The person at the helm does not have to be the same female for the entire race or for the entire series. A boat is racing from her preparatory signal until she finishes and clears the finishing line and marks or retires. The Race Committee shall be informed as to the name of the female(s) at the helm at the end of each race.

ENTRY: There is no entry fee. NYC membership is not required.

SCHEDULE: The 5-minute warning signal will be at 1700 hours on each Thursday on the following dates: July 30th, August 13th, 20th, 27th, 2015. All Classes start at 1705.
